- Designs must stay in good taste. Please refrain from political, religious or controversial statements within the designs.
- Do not put anything on the Scarecrow that is of value or importance.
- All Parts of the scarecrow must be securely fastened.
- Contest hosts and festival organizers assume no responsibility for the loss, theft or damage to the entry.
- All entries should be attached to the posts using twine, tie wrap, rope or zip ties. They must not be adhered to posts using tape, screws, wires or any product which may damage the lampposts.
- Scarecrows must be maintained by those displaying them.
- Scarecrows must be weather resistant and sturdy.
- Scarecrows must not block or obstruct any view to vehicles or pedestrian traffic.
- Scarecrows can placed, beginning Sept. 16<sup>th</sup>.
